

Emanuele Moraca: Composer, producer, songwriter, arranger and drummer.

Born 03/31/2000. A child of art, he entered the artistic world early on thanks to his mother, a pianist and classical concert pianist; his father, a creative songwriter; and his maternal grandfather, Saverio Porzano, a former tenor in the world and at La Scala Theater in Milan. At the age of 6, Emanuele began his experience as a mime at La Scala Theater in Milan in many operas and ballets, collaborating with internationally renowned artists including maestro Daniele Gatti, singers such as Stuart Neil, Fiorenza Cedolins and Ferruccio Furlanetto, directors including Gabriele Lavia, Stephane Braunschweig, and with étoile Roberto Bolle, until the age of 15, participating in 2008 in the opening of the theater season on Dec. 7 as an actor in Giuseppe Verdi's opera Don Carlo, broadcast worldwide; furthermore, after taking and passing admission competitions in 2006 for both the children's voice choir of the G. Verdi and for the propaedeutics of the corps de ballet of Teatro alla Scala, he chose to pursue dance until 2013. In 2011 he discovered a passion for percussion instruments, studying drums, percussion, theory and musical solfeggio with maestro Massimo Omini; already at the age of thirteen he began performing with musical groups of different styles; among the most important events were his participation in Amnesty International alongside singer-songwriter Michelangelo Giordano: also in Veneto, he opened with the same the concert of Mario Venuti; he was a guest together with Giordano at the State University of Milan; he was an artist, together with the same, at the opening of Carmen Consoli's concert in Piedmont; and together with M. Giordano participated in the M.E.I. in Faenza. The collaboration as a drummer and percussionist with the singer-songwriter Michelangelo Giordano goes from 2013 to 2017; we also remember the participation as a guest on Radio Number one together with the group New Sound, with whom he collaborated as a musician from 2014 to 2018, and as a DJ at the Real Beach in Desio. Emanuele participated as a drummer in the recording of two records, one by Riccardo Moraca and one by New Sound. With his mother he began studying piano, later devoting himself to the study from jazz harmony, soul, and rnb

Emanuele Moraca has also collaborated since 2019 as producer, arranger, and composer with Manuel De Pascali, a graduate of CPM in Milan, whose EP he produced that year. Since late 2021 he has been studying songwriting with master Mario Fanizzi, graduated at Berklee in Boston, who has collaborated with several artists including Annalisa, Mario Biondi, Renato Zero, Alessio Bernabei, Random, Arisa. In recent years he works alongside as a musician and composer the young singer-songwriter Ale Pinto, with whom he supports various live performances including the biassono gp (main stage) at the Monza Grand Prix.

Since the year 2022 he has been collaborating as composer, author, with RAI, in particular for the realization of jingles for isoradio.
